


Your **Gifts from the Heart** were given to agencies in the Peoria area and Orphan Grain Train. Thanks for your generosity!

District Mission Grants Proposals Requested

"Mission grant proposals shall be submitted in resolution form to the Vice President of Mission Grants at least six (6) months prior to the District convention. Proposals may be submitted by LWML members, societies, units, zones and LCMS Boards. (Bylaws Article XV, Section1)

Ministries seeking funding should:

be mission in emphasis, extending the ministry of the Word;

fit into the plans and projections of the LCMS;

be current and ready for implementation;

be on-going in nature, continuing after the grant money has been expended."

The grant proposal must be submitted by September 30, 2011 to the Vice President of Mission Grants - download the printable form on the www.ndlwml.org/missiongrants webpage.
